

Eight scholarships covering tuition fee for UK university exchange, accommodation fee, maintenance allowance and air fare for one academic year



# Purpose

The Alistair Harvey Foundation Scholarship (the Scholarship) aims to provide students, who are nominated by Technological and Higher Education Institute of Hong Kong (THEi), with sponsorship to undertake exchange programmes at universities in the United Kingdom (UK) for one year. The awardees have to obtain admission to a related science and technology Degree programme in the UK for AY 2019/20.

# Eligibility Criteria

An applicant must:

- be born in Hong Kong and that at least one of his/her parents must be born in Hong Kong;
- be a full-time student in Year 1 studying a specified science and technology related degree programme at THEi<sup>Note1</sup>;
- have excellent academic achievements and non-academic attainments including heavy involvement in extra-curricular activities and community services;
- be fully committed to undertake the exchange programme at a UK university recommended by THEi<sup>Note1</sup>;
- fulfill all application procedures and admission requirements of a related science and technology degree programme at an institution recommended by THEi; and
- · be proficient in English by taking IELTS with no less than overall score 6.0.

#### Note 1

Current Year 1 students studying the following full-time science and technology degree programmes at THEi are eligible to apply for the Scholarship. Successful applicants will be arranged by THEi to study a related science and technology degree programme at a UK university, as specified in the table below. Please note that information in the following table is tentative. THEi reserves the right to revise the list of THEi programmes, UK Universities and their programmes without prior notice.

# **Number of Awards**

The number of scholarships for AY 2019/20 will be 8. The Interview Panel of the Scholarship will make their recommendations based on the academic performance, non-academic achievements, commitment to studying abroad and interview performance of the candidates.



# **Conditions of the Scholarships**


- The award of the Scholarship is conditional upon the applicant being offered a place by a university in the UK as recommended by THEi, and meeting certain health and immigration requirements.
- The degree programme that the awardee will study for the exchange programme should be a related science and technology programme that is arranged by THEI<sup>Note1</sup>;
- The awardee is required:
  - to pursue study diligently and to conform to all the rules of the university;
  - not to transfer to another educational institution during the programme of study without the consent of the Trustees and THEi;
  - to keep in close contact with THEi and the Foundation and, in particular, to keep all parties informed of all changes including address in the UK even if only temporary, or curtailment, or intended curtailment of studies; and
  - to submit proof of satisfactory academic performance with "Annual Report" to the Foundation and THEi by July of 2020.
- 4. Upon completion of the academic exchange programme, the awardee should forward/arrange to forward a copy of the transcript issued by the host institution and submit a completed application form for <u>credit transfer together with the</u> <u>processing fee</u> to the concerned Faculty Office so that credit transfer can be arranged. The institute may refuse to grant credit transfer to the awardee for modules with grades below the equivalent of grade B- in THEi's grading system.
- 5. After the academic exchange, the duration of the awardee's remaining study at THEi will depend on the number of credits that could be transferred to THEi. Before applying for this exchange programme, students should consult the respective Faculty and Programme Leader for details of his / her study plan.
- The awardee should pay the normal tuition fee during the year of exchange to THEi (including fee for modules that may be accepted for credit transfer), the tuition fee to the host institution however will be paid for by the Alistair Harvey Foundation.
- The awardee's acceptance of the Scholarship shall constitute a contract between the awardee and the administrator of the Foundation. THEi has no obligation in this regard.
- 8. The awardee accepts that the Scholarship may be terminated at any time if and when the performance as reported by the institution is considered by the Foundation as unsatisfactory, or when he /she for any reason ceases to be a full-time undergraduate.
- Consent from the Foundation and THEi should be sought if the awardee intends to defer for / withdraw from the programme studying and / or THEi.

## Interview

Suitable candidates will be invited to attend the 1<sup>st</sup> interview. Final interview will be arranged for shortlisted candidates. The performance of the interviewees will form a crucial assessment component.

# Application for the Scholarship

The Foundation has the right to accept / not to accept the application. The decision of the Foundation is final. Completed Application Form must be submitted through the Faculty together with proven documents to the Registry of THEi on or before 01 March 2019.



# **Application Guide**

- 1. Please complete every item in BLOCK letters and in black ink.
- Where appropriate, please put down "NO", "NIL" or "NA"; and to ensure that the form is completed with accurate information. If there is insufficient space, please provide details in separate sheet and be enclosed with the completed form.
- Your provision of all the personal data requested in this form is obligatory. Your application will not be considered if you fail to provide all required information or it is not clear from your statements that you have fulfilled the criteria for the award of the Scholarship.
- 4. After submission of the application form, you are obliged to notify Academic Services Manager of the Registry of THEi if there are any subsequent changes to the information provided, including correspondence address.
- 5. The completed Application Form must be submitted through the Faculty with the recommendation from the Programme Leader / Head of Department together with the following documents:

(Note: Do not send any originals of diplomas / certificates or other qualification documents, the copies submitted will not be returned)

- a. A copy of your THEi Student Identity Card;
- b. A copy each of your parent's and your Birth Certificate, Hong Kong Identity Card;
- Copies of supporting documents including the academic transcripts and record of the extra-curricular activities / community services;
- d. Result of International English Language Testing System (IELTS).
- \* Failure to attach a proof of IELTS result may lead to your admission application be rejected by the UK University.
- 6. You are advised to make a photocopy of the completed application for your own reference.
