CAR-ASHRAE Technical Seminar 2018 -

"High Performing Buildings" in Beijing



A half-day technical seminar titled "High Performing Buildings" jointly organized with the Chinese Association of Refrigeration (CAR), ASHRAE and ASHRAE Hong Kong Chapter, co-organized by CAR-ASHRAE Beijing Group and CAR-ASHRAE Shanghai Group and supported by Indoor Air Quality Association Inc. was successfully held in Beijing, China on 10 April 2018. The theme of the seminar was titled as "Building Commissioning, Operation & Maintenance'. Around 30 participants attended the technical seminar. Mr. Jeff Littleton, ASHRAE Executive Vice President and friends from ASHRAE Region XIII also joined this event.



Mr. Jin Jiawei, CAR President, delivered the welcome address before the seminar started. Prof. Bjarne W. Olesen, Society President delivered a keynote speech titled "ASHRAE Update", following by the sharing of Mr. Xia Lin, Deputy Chief Engineer of Arcplus Group PLC, Shanghai Archi-Scientific Creation Center, on "Green Operation and Maintenance for Shanghai Xian Dai Shen Du Building". Then, ASHRAE Society Vice President, Mr. Edward Tsui presented "Retro-Commissioning through Big Data Analytics".

After the tea break, *Mr. Rumen Yordanov*, Technical Committee Chair of Platinum Hong Kong and LEED International Roundtable Representative, presented the topic of "Implementation of ASHRAE Commissioning Guidelines for LEED Projects".















Prof. Wei Qingpeng from Department of Building Technology and Science, Tsinghua University shared his experience on "Commissioning through Every Stage of HVAC System Installation and Premier Operation: A Case Study". Finally, Mr. Ng Yong-Kong, Director and Regional Chair of ASHRAE Region XIII, delivered the closing address.





APCBE Steering Committee Update

In CRC 2017 Singapore, the APCBE Steering Committee had proposed the APCBE Framework and Guidelines (Revision 2) in the Business Section No.1. The motion of 'To adopt the APCBE Framework and Guidelines (Revision 2) proposed by APCBE Steering Committee' was approved by Chapter Delegates. During the APCBE Steering Committee Meeting on 25 August 2017, Taiwan Chapter was awarded to host the APCBE 2019 with the highest votes. In addition, Dr. Manuel Belino (Philippines) and Prof. Shinsuke Kato (Japan) were elected as the APCBE Steering Committee members during Executive & Caucus Section.




Chapters Regional Conference Update

ASHRAE Hong Kong Chapter will host the 21st ASHRAE Region XIII Chapters Regional Conference (CRC) in Crowne Plaza Hong Kong Kowloon East on 17-18 August 2018 and 1st Regional Planning Meeting for 2018-19 on 19 August 2018.

The Chapters Regional Conference (CRC) is one of the biggest annual events for ASHRAE Region XIII. Delegates from 10 ASHRAE Chapter Countries in Asia Pacific Region (Hong Kong, Singapore, Malaysia, Taiwan, Philippines, Thailand, Indonesia, Japan, South Korea and Macao) will participate in the CRC.

Hong Kong Chapter will organize the pre-CRC activities like the 1st Joint Chapters Research Promotion (RP) Sports Tournament – Bowling Competition and golf outing on 16 August 2018. In addition, welcome reception will be held in the evening of the same day to welcome the overseas participants. This CRC will organize Technical Program and Student Program. On Day 1, Technical Seminar on 'Building Retro-Commissioning for System Optimization' will be held in the morning session that 4 experienced speakers, ASHRAE Distinguished Lecturer, Mr. Hoy R. Bohanon and local experts including Ir Kong Ka-wah, Ir Cary Chan and Ir Dr. Raymond Yau are invited to share their experiences on Building Retro-Commissioning to promote energy savings for existing buildings. The Student Program includes student forum, competition as well as technical tour. Besides, there will also have Spouse Tour, Presidential Luncheon, Business Sections, Caucus Sessions, APCBE Steering Committee Meetings, Banquet Dinner, Women in ASHRAE (WIA) Session, Workshops, Host Chapter Luncheon and Awards Presentation in this CRC.

Research Promotion Update

Mr Ong Ching Loon, RP RVC

Region XIII's performance on RP contribution is far below the goals set by our DRC. More critical is the fact that the performance of Region XIII on RP as at end April 2018 when compared with the other 14 regions was the worst. The RP Campaign of this fiscal year will end on 15th June 2018.

Region XIII's goal for 2017-2018 is US\$ 48,200. This goal is 8.7% less than the US\$ 52,396 which was collectively contributed in 2016-2017. What it implies is that the goal of US\$48,200 is achievable.

Once again, my thanks go to all of you for your commitments and conviction to the cause of RP. Let's deliver our goals and raise the flag of Region XIII high!
