80-100 (A- to A, GP = 3.7 to 4)	Excellent – first rate work in most respects, showing full understanding of purpose; knowledge of related work; choice and use of appropriate research methods; originality; well-developed skills; personal commitment.
70-79 (B to B+, GP = 3.0 to 3.3)	Very Good – showing strength in many respects, e.g. appreciation of needs, marshalling of relevant material; logical approach; sound interpretation; good presentation; persistence.
65-69 (B-, GP = 2.7)	Good – solid work, showing some limitations in, e.g. understanding of requirements; choice of approach; development of argument; use of references and background material; layout application.
55-64 (C to C+, GP = 2.0 to 2.3)	Satisfactory – basically sound, but showing weaknesses in, e.g. grasp of concepts; knowledge of related work; planning; interpretation of findings; clarity of presentation; effort.
40-54 (D to C-, GP = 1.0 to 1.7)	Adequate/Pass – showing appreciation of aims; but significant lapses in e.g. understanding; choice and use of procedures; development of argument; soundness of conclusions; personal commitment.
<40 (F, GP = 0)	Unsatisfactory/Fail – showing failure to understand aims; confusion over e.g. plans, methods, arguments, meanings; lack of effort.
