COOL THERMAL ENERGY STORAGE IN THE ERA OF SUSTAINABILITY DR. WILLIAM P. BAHNFLETH, PhD, PE

Dr. Bahnfleth is Professor and Director of the Indoor Environment Center in the Department of Architectural Engineering at the Pennsylvania State University (Penn State) in University Park, PA, where he has been employed since 1994. Previously, he was a Senior Consultant for ZBA, Inc. in Cincinnati, OH and a Principal Investigator at the U.S. Army Construction Engineering Research Laboratory in Champaign, IL. He holds BS, MS, and PhD degrees in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Illinois, where he also earned an undergraduate degree in music (pipe organ performance), and is a registered professional engineer. He is the author or co-author of more than 100 technical papers and 11 books and book chapters. He consults regularly on the design of chilled water thermal energy storage systems and has been involved in more than 20 projects worldwide.

Dr. Bahnfleth is a fellow of both ASHRAE and the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) and is also a member of the International Society for Indoor Air Quality and Climate (ISIAQ), the International Building Performance Simulation Association (IBPSA), Sigma Xi, the American Society for Engineering Education (ASEE), and the Society of Building Science Educators (SBSE). He has served ASHRAE in a variety of capacities, including Student Branch Advisor, Chapter Governor, Technical Committee and Standing Committee Chair, and as Director-at-Large, Vice President, Treasurer, and 2013-14 Society President. He is the recipient of a 1st place ASHRAE Technology Award, Transactions Paper Award, and Distinguished Service and Exceptional Service Awards.



WHY BUILDINGS MATTER AND THE ROLE OF ASHRAE 90.1 R. CHRISTOPHER MATHIS

Mr. Mathis serves as president of Mathis Consulting Company and has spent the past 30 years focusing on how buildings and building products perform – from energy efficiency to code compliance to sustainability and long-term performance durability.

Chris has published a variety of technical papers on topics including: advanced test methods for insulation materials and wall systems; daylighting design and assessment techniques; off-peak cooling techniques for commercial office buildings; new residential and commercial energy codes; and metrics for environmentally preferable products. He has conducted workshops for thousands of builders, architects,

engineers, building officials, policy makers and others in the building industry on a variety of building science topics. He is a 30-year member of ASHRAE, serving on numerous committees and in ASHRAE Standards development. He served for 12 years on SSPC 90.1 helping to develop the nation's model energy code for commercial buildings. He currently serves on SPPC 90.2 and is the Energy Consultant to SSPC 189.1 and the Chapter Technology Transfer Committee (CTTC). Chris has been selected four times to serve on the International Energy Conservation Code Committee, selected for the ICC Sustainable Building Technology Committee where he helped to develop the first drafts of the International Green Construction Code (IGCC).

Chris received a Master of Science in Architecture Studies from MIT where his graduate work focused on energy use in buildings. Chris is also an on-going student of about 90 million years of sustainability and building science through his activities as a beekeeper. He lives and works near the farm he grew up on in the beautiful mountains of Western North Carolina.



ASHRAE'S ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PHILIPPINES' GREEN BUILDING CODE AR. EMELITO C. PUNSALAN

Mr. Punsalan is an architect, environmental planner and green building specialist with over 20 years of planning, design and construction experience. He is a member of the United Architects of the Philippines, ASHRAE Philippines Chapter and the Philippine Green Building Initiative where he is currently Vice President for Technical. He co-authored the GREEEN Building Rating System of PGBI and is part of the training seminar faculty. He is involved in the green building assessment of a number of building projects, most notably the Hyundai Logistics Center in Laguna, Hyundai Dealerships and the National Museum of

Natural History.

He is also a technical consultant for the International Finance Corporation (IFC), a member of the World Bank Group that has worked on Green Building ordinance of Mandaluyong City and most recently, the Philippine Green Building Code under the Department of Public Works and Highways. He has also participated in the first Building Energy Quotient (BEQ) assessment of an existing building in the Philippines, and in Asia.
